Welcome – to those of you who have attended AmberCon UK before and newcomers alike! AmberCon UK '11 will be our eighteenth annual roleplaying convention devoted to the Amber Diceless Roleplaying Game and we hope you will join us there.

Where? For the third time, we will be at Harben House, Newport Pagnell, near Milton Keynes, just off junction 14 of the M1, and 20 miles from Luton airport. Full details of the hotel will be sent out before the convention. The hotel has a sauna and gym, free internet access, and plenty of free parking.

What's planned? Just as Amber is not an ordinary RPG, AmberCon UK is no ordinary game convention. AmberCon UK '11 will feature events for players of all levels of experience, including new character auctions, stand-alone scenarios, new and continuing mini-campaigns, freeform games and the chance to meet, relax with, and plot hideously against your fellow Amber players in comfort.

As always, we will be scheduling non-stop gaming from Friday evening through to late Sunday afternoon; there's no downtime at the convention unless *you* want it! On Saturday evening as usual, there will be the AmberCon UK Banquet.

What are the membership costs?

Residential membership includes dinner on the Friday night, accommodation for the nights of Friday 15th and Saturday 16th July, full English breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings, VAT and convention membership. All rooms contain a double bed, but there is no discount for sharing. A limited number of non-residential memberships are also available. *All memberships also include lunch on both Saturday and Sunday.* Costs are as follows:

Residential membership	£145 per person
Non-residential membership	£62 per person
AmberCon UK Banquet	£20 per person

A non-returnable deposit of £25 is needed by **1st May 2011** to secure your membership. Full payment should be received by **31st May 2011**.

AmberCon UK '11 - The Games

AmberCon UK depends on its games, and the games depend on you, the GMs. (Yes, that's YOU!) If you've run a game for us before, then you know you want to run another one, if you haven't, then now's your chance! All GMs are always greatly appreciated. Guidelines for writing your game description are below.

The game schedule will be sent to all registered members at the end of May, and members will have up to two weeks to make their choices. Games will then be allocated, and players and GMs will have a few weeks to discuss characters, thereby allowing everyone to be fully prepared in advance.

Game descriptions should contain:

1. GM Name

2. Game Title

3. Game Description

Please keep this fairly short, wherever possible. If you have large amounts of background information for your players, you might want to include a web address.

4. Character Restrictions

This should include the guidelines for creating characters. You should also mention what sort of game it is (e.g. crossover, elders, freeform) or whether it is a continuation from previous years, whether new players are accepted and anything else you think your players should know about your game.

5. Number of players

We will aim to assign you no more players than the number you state, but that might not always be possible. If your game has a definite upper or lower limit on the number of players, please let us know.

6. Preferred Game Slot

There are 4 game slots at AmberCon UK:

Slot 1 (Friday evening 7:30pm until late)

Slot 2 (Saturday day 9am - 5pm)

Slot 3 (Saturday evening 7:30pm until late)

Slot 4 (Sunday 10am - 6pm)

The evening slots are usually shorter than the day slots. Slot 3 will probably be the shortest, about 5 hours.

Continuation games will tend to be in the same slot as in any previous year.
