Welcome – to those of you who have attended AmberCon UK before and newcomers alike! AmberCon UK '07 will be our fifteenth annual roleplaying convention devoted to the Amber Diceless Roleplaying Game and we hope you will join us there.

Where? For the tenth year running, we will be in the Renaissance Hotel in the centre of Reading, just a 40-mile drive or a 25-minute rail journey away from London. Full details of the hotel will be sent out before the convention. The hotel has a swimming pool and hot tub, and adequate free parking.

What's planned? Just as Amber is not an ordinary RPG, AmberCon UK is no ordinary game convention. AmberCon UK '07 will feature events for players of all levels of experience, including new character auctions, stand-alone scenarios, new and continuing mini-campaigns, freeform games and the chance to meet, relax with, and plot hideously against your fellow Amber players in the comfort of a 4-star hotel.

As always, we will be scheduling non-stop gaming from Friday evening through to late Sunday afternoon; there's no downtime at the convention unless *you* want it! On Saturday evening as usual, there will be the AmberCon UK Banquet.

What are the membership costs?

Residential membership includes accommodation for the nights of Friday 13th and Saturday 14th July, full English breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings, VAT and convention membership. A limited number of non-residential memberships are also available. Costs are as follows:

Membership with accommodation in a Twin or Double Room	£112 per person
Membership with accommodation in a Single Room	£157 per person
Non-residential membership	£40 per person
AmberCon UK Banquet	£15 per person

A non-returnable deposit of £25 is needed to secure your membership. All bookings should be received (with full payment) by **31st May 2007**.

AmberCon UK '07 - The Games

AmberCon UK depends on its games, and the games depend on you, the GMs. (Yes, that's YOU!) If you've run a game for us before, then you know you want to run another one, if you haven't, then now's your chance! All GMs are always greatly appreciated. Guidelines for writing your game description are below.

The hotel has some 'executive' bedrooms, with an additional 'relaxation area'. If you are willing to run your game in your room, you may be allocated one of these at no extra cost.

Game descriptions should contain:

1. GM Name

2. Game Title

3. Game Description

Please keep this fairly short, wherever possible. If you have large amounts of background information for your players, you might want to include a web address.

4. Character Restrictions

This should include the guidelines for creating characters. You should also mention what sort of game it is (e.g. crossover, elders, freeform) or whether it is a continuation from previous years and whether new players are accepted.

5. Number of players

We will aim to assign you no more players than the number you state, but that might not always be possible. If your game has a definite upper or lower limit on the number of players, please let us know.

6. Preferred Game Slot

There are 4 game slots at AmberCon UK:

Slot 1 (Friday evening)

Slot 2 (Saturday day)

Slot 3 (Saturday evening)

Slot 4 (Sunday)

The evening slots will probably be shorter than the day slots. Slot 3 will probably be the shortest, about 5 hours.

Continuation games will tend to be in the same slot at last year.

7. Whether you're willing to run your game in your room.

The 'executive' rooms are only available as single or double rooms, not twin rooms. Also, they are only large enough for the smaller games.
